

# CERTIFICATION AS “UNITEDLINUX CERTIFIED PROFESSIONAL” AND “UNITEDLINUX CERTIFIED EXPERT”

Complex IT systems necessitate a high level of technical skill and knowledge on the part of employees and IT service providers. Therefore, the deployment of qualified, competent IT personnel is imperative. In this context, a certificate obtained by means of a recognized exam is an invaluable asset for substantiating the acquired expertise to the own company and to customers. A certification helps enterprises to gain a clear competitive edge and elevate the quality standard. Furthermore, the additional qualification increases the chances of individuals in the job market.

The two-level UnitedLinux certification, which is prepared in collaboration with the Linux Professional Institute (LPI), is based on the globally recognized LPI certification. The successful completion of the LPI exams 101 and 102 is a precondition for the first level. At this stage, you are already LPIC-1 (LPI Certified Level 1). If you pass the UnitedLinux exam 103, you will be awarded the title UnitedLinux Certified Professional (ULCP). In order to be eligible for the second level of the UnitedLinux certification, you must be LPIC-2 (LPI Certified Level 2), i.e. you must have passed the LPI exams 201 and 202 and obtained the title ULCP. Upon successful completion of the UnitedLinux exam 203, you will be awarded the title UnitedLinux Certified Expert (ULCE). The courses of SuSE Training on the basis of SuSE Linux Enterprise Server 8 prepare you thoroughly for this certification.
